Important Development (June 17) re: RoHPV Response to Minto Past Deadline

Breaking News for Residents of 255 Glenlake:

As we shared with you in our announcement yesterday Minto High Park Village [provided their response](#) to our cease and desist letter. After careful consideration **we have determined Minto's response to be insufficient.**

RoHPV provided [our response to Minto](#) today and **we strongly encourage all residents of 255 Glenlake Ave to read it now.**

Why Minto's Response Is Insufficient:

- In [our cease and desist letter](#), we respectfully asked Minto for a written response **not only** confirming that they will cease commencement of this work, but **additionally to respond to the 'Six Asks' outlined by RoHPV and supported by more than 230 residents.** Minto **has not responded** to these remaining 'asks'.
- While Minto shared with us that they will delay the project until August 2, this is in fact **providing the least possible notice required** in order to **comply with law**, as they now view the June 3 communication as legal and proper notice.

We **do not take this to be a gesture of goodwill to residents or an appropriate response to your concerns.** Minto has lost the trust and confidence of its residents and **must do much more than the minimum required by law in order to regain it.**

- Given the numerous failures in the planning of this project [outlined in our original letter](#), we believe that the **46 days** that remain will be **insufficient time for Minto to properly reevaluate, replan and execute this project in a way that addresses residents' significant and legitimate concerns.**

In a show of good faith, **RoHPV has extended the deadline** provided for Minto's **complete and detailed written response** to our "Six Asks" to **no later than Friday, June 24 at 5pm.**
